Dive into the most ecologically diverse fresh water environment in the world! We offer courses to suit every level, from those first bubbles to the professional ranks of Divemaster.

Lake Malawi has over 1000 species of fish, many endemic to the Lake, which is more than all the freshwater species in Europe and North America combined. Likoma is widely regarded as having the best diving on the Lake, both in terms of the diversity of fish species and their sheer abundance. With a vast array of colourful Cichlids, Mouthbrooders, Catfish up to two metres in length and the occasional otter, Likoma is a beautiful dive location.

Besides aquatic life, there are also spectacular underwater rock formations, swim throughs, a 30-metre wall and even a mysterious rock carving!

We have three dive boats, accommodating up to 10 divers. DAN oxygen kit and first aid is always on board the dive vessel. We have full sets of new Oceanic equipment, which is inspected daily

Discover Scuba Diving

Discover the magical underwater world of Likoma Island with a half day adventure for those who want to try scuba diving for the first time. The experience includes basic dive theory, a pool or shallow water training and a dive in the Lake.

Open Water Diver

Learn to dive with the world's best known dive certification course. Experience the fun and excitement of diving as our professional PADI instructors introduce you to the underwater world. This lifetime qualification is recognized worldwide, allowing you to dive wherever your travels take you. The course lasts 3 to 4 days, and includes theory and pool sessions along with 4 open water dives.

Scuba Diver

Want to get certified but short on time? Then this course is for you! The scuba diver course certifies you to dive up to 12m under the guidance of a diving professional anywhere in the world.

This is the first half of the open water course which includes 2 dives, and takes around 1 1/2 to 2 days. You can always upgrade to Open Water at a later date!

Advanced Diver and Specialty Courses

Extend your diving knowledge and skill with our Advanced Diver (5 dives), Adventure Diver (3 dives) or Specialty Diver courses (2-4 dives). Continue your diving education with activities such as night diving, deep diving, underwater photography, navigation, search and recovery, buoyancy control among many more.
